- Physical harassment – unwelcomed physical contact (touching a person without permission)
- Verbal harassment – making negative or offensive comments about other members of the GESC 2016 programme, not only within the University grounds but on the internet or via telecommunications.
- Physical violence of any sort, including towards another person or property within and around the UniMAP's Sg. Chuchuh campus and UniMAP's campus at large.
